Instructions for Independent Nominating Petition Volunteers

1) You must be a registered voter in New York State

2) The person signing the petition must also be a registered voter in NY State; if they say they are not sure, apologize and move on to the next house/person.
3) You cannot sign the petition <u>you are carrying</u>; anotherwords, you can't be a witness to your own signature. <u>You DO fill out all your information in the witness section.</u>

5) You <u>can</u> fill in the signers date, address and City, Town (or must be County if a Borough of New York City) but they have to sign their own signature. No villages... Better to go door to door because then all the signers are from the same town, city or Borough. In NYC, there are overlapping Congressional Districts so try to only get people in the same city blocks. If you know the Congressional District, write it in PENCIL on the top right corner of the form please.
